Simpson also pointed out that the comfort, quality care, and security of living at Northland Village will be affordable, noting that the basic monthly fee is favorable compared to similar facilities. Northland Village provides referrals to St. Louis County Health and Human Services for residents who may qualify for financial assistance.

Northland Village was developed and is owned by the Northland Foundation. Maintaining both high quality and affordability were essential to the Foundation's decision to enter the realm of assisted living, consistent with its longstanding mission and commitment to supporting older adults in rural areas to remain independent and active in their communities. Buhl is the Foundation's second assisted living community. The first Northland Village opened in McGregor, Minnesota, in April 2007.
